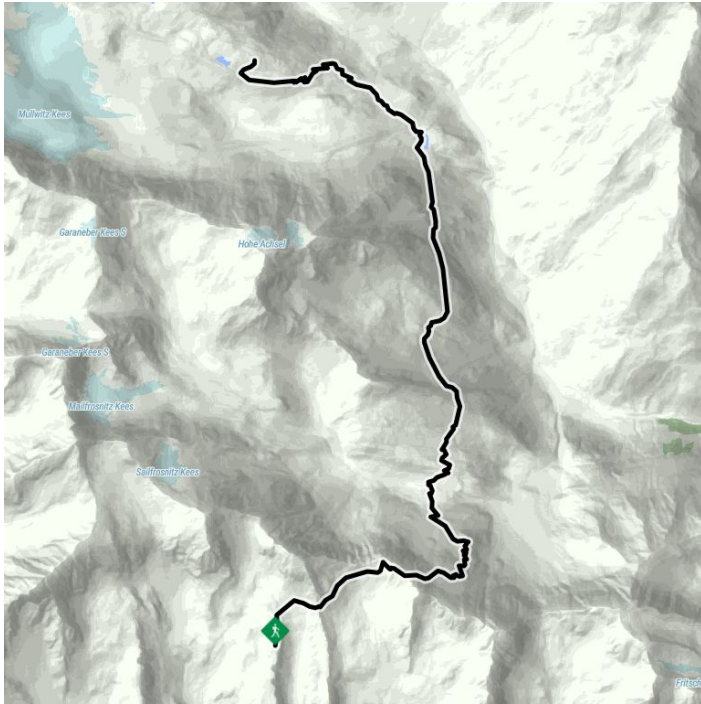
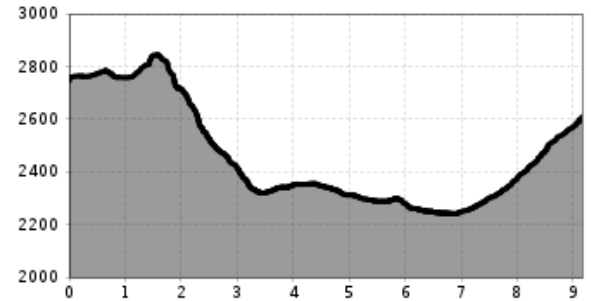


The key section of the Venediger Altitude Trail

Description

Via the Kälberscharte (2.791m) and the Galtenscharte (2,871 m) the route continues to the **Badener Hütte**. This section is, depending on snow conditions, often only accessible in high summer. A short section is also secured with a rope, but can be easily climbed without a via ferrata set. Due to the danger of falling rocks, however, this section should only be climbed in dry conditions. The rest of the route leads through the picturesque and rustic Frosnitzal valley to the Badenerhütte.
