

From Dolomitenhütte car park via the standard route to Karlsbader Hütte, from there continue under the southern cliff face of the Rote Turm and the Schmittband until you come to the foot of the southern flanks of the Kl. Laserzkopf
public transport:

Ausgehend vom Parkplatz Dolomitenhütte erreicht man über den Normalweg die Karlsbader Hütte und folgt von dort aus der Südwand des Roten Turmes. Vorbei am Schmittband gelangt man zum Einstieg am Fuß der Südflanke des Kl. Laserzkopfes.

Abstieg: Der Abstieg erfolgt über von der Großen Sandspitze über den Ari-Schübel-Steig. Man kann auch, etwas schwieriger, über den Gebirgsjägersteig zum Weg zur Karlsbaderhütte absteigen.

Beschreibung

The Panorama-via ferrata route is a combination of the 'Sepp-Oberlechner-Gedächtnisweg' trail (from Kl. Laserzkopf to Gr. Sandspitze) with the 'Gebirgsjägersteig' and the 'Ari-Schuhbel-Steig' on the south side of the Gr. and Kl. Sandspitze. To cross the highest located ridge in the Lienz Dolomites, with seven summits of between 2690 m and 2772 m, a good level of fitness, sure-footedness and experience in the mountains is definitely required. Superb views to the mountains in East Tyrol and breath-taking views into the distance from the highest summits in the Lienz Dolomites!

Equipment: complete via ferrata gear and helmet (in spring possibly crampons, ice pick and an additional safety rope).

Special features: Impressive views down to the depths and a few very high climbing sections. There is an emergency exit route at the Böse Schartl. The route may of course also be tackled in reverse.
