




Altitude profile

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Description

The starting point of this walk is the Korberplatz. From there you follow the street Virgener Straße up to the Café Patterer. At this junction you must first turn right and then left onto the street Pattergasse. Follow the Pattergasse until reaching the sports store "Sport Steiner". Here you turn right and walk in the direction of the Parish Church St. Alban and the Nationalparkhaus. The baroque-classicist parish church is the largest country cathedral in Tyrol. The Nationalparkhaus, which provides information about the flora and fauna of the Hohe Tauern National Park in 6 adventure rooms and through spectacular videos and exhibitions, is also worth a visit. The walk continues by passing by the parish church and going through the underpass onto the street Goldriedstraße. Then continue via Klaunz to the farmhouse Huberhof. After passing the Huberhof, follow the path over a small stream through the forest to Klausen. Soon you will come across the chapel Chrysanthkapelle (or also Klausner Kirchle) in Klausen. On the ceiling of the chapel Chrysanthkapelle are painted the "Finding of the Cross" and the papal medallions of Gregory and Sylvester. Then the path leads through the forest to the district Vogelsang. To finish the walk, cross the road in the direction of Feld and then cross the bridge to the bus stop Feld, which is located on the Felbertauern road (B108).
