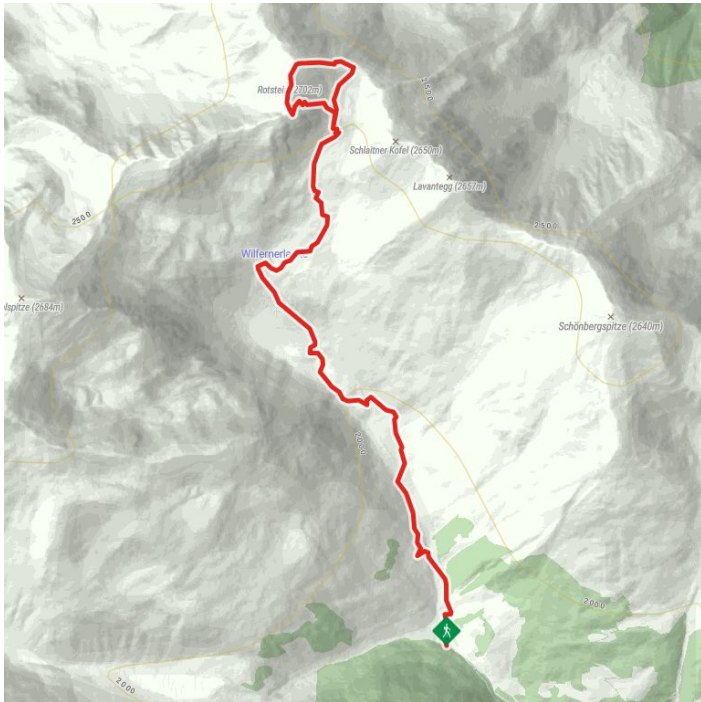
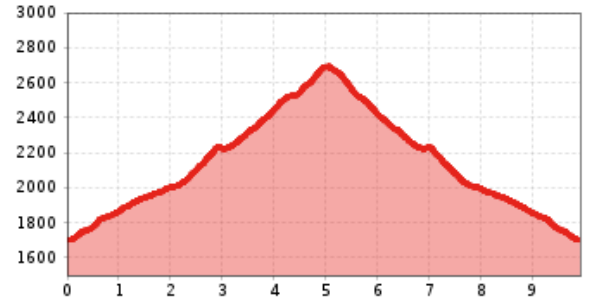

## Description

From Lienz by car to Thal, then bear right on the Pustertaler Höhenstraße road to Assling Wildlife Park. Take a right there to Wilferntal, passing the Warscherbauer to the head of the valley at Wilferntal, 1701m. 'Parking available'. From the car park across the bridge, heading north, up the agricultural road to Huber Kaser, take a left here, continue in a northerly direction to the Wilfernerlacke. Continue up to the wind gap between Schlaitenkofel and Rotstein, via the easy climb on the eastern ridge up to the summit, 2702m.
