## Description

Starting point is the car park near the valley station for Zetttersfeld cable car. From there take the gondola to the Zetttersfeld 1812 m then take the 4-seater chair lift to the Steinermandl 2213 m. Continue on the well signposted 'AV' hiking trail, no. 913 north, south-west of the Goiselemandl via Neualplschneid to the southern banks of Neualplseen. At the information boards on the southern banks proceed along a moraine and get to the area to the west of the Seenplatte. After a few rocky sections proceed via rough, boulder terrain crossing here and there, continuing up to the southern edge of the summit ridge, before you finally reach the cross which has long been in your line of sight. After a few metres altitude you are then at the actual summit at 2905 m.
