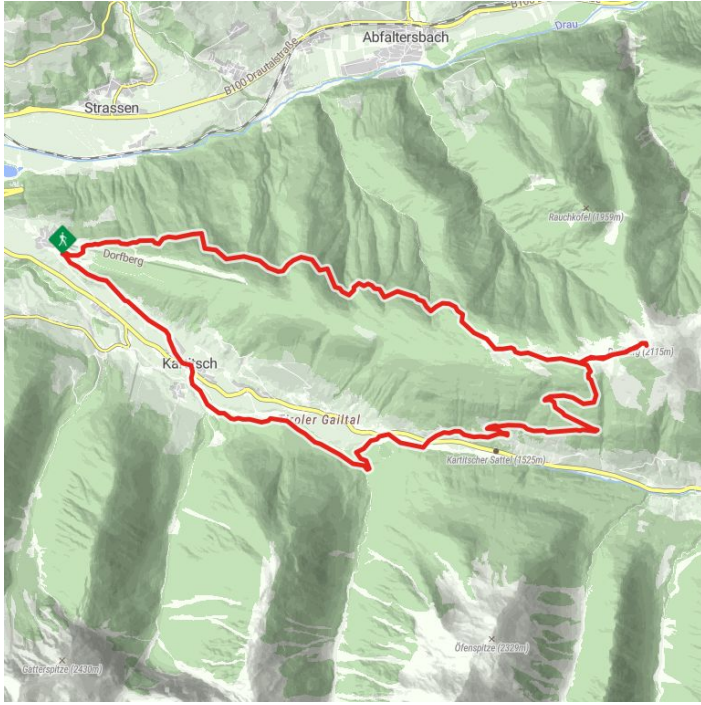
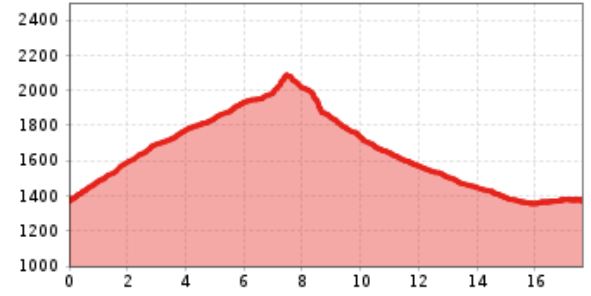

From there hike to the right, past the T-bar lift route, conveniently then via route no. 229 to the Ochsenwiesen, continuing to the summit of the Dorfberg. The Dorfberg is the local mountain in Kartitsch.
