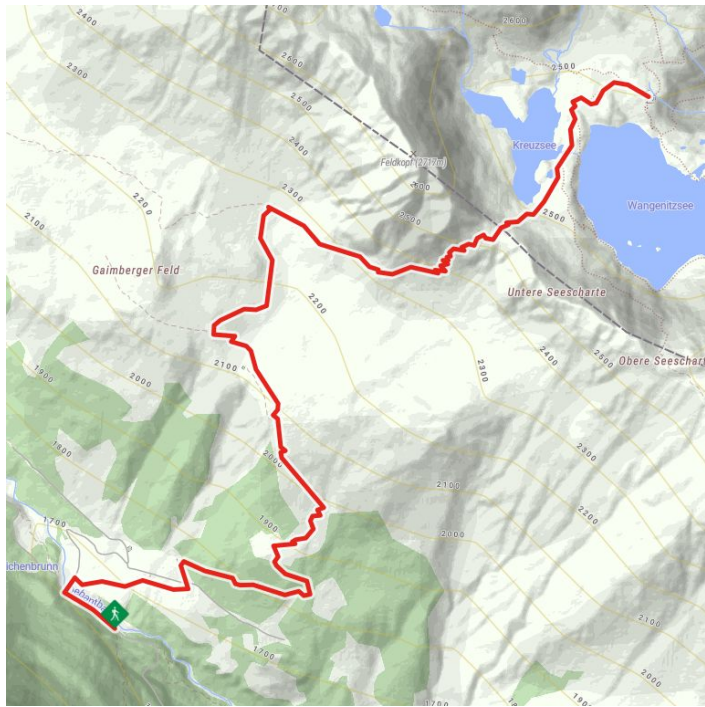


# Alpine hike to Wangenitzsee Hütte
